## Corona Who?...Safety First!

The coronavirus, also known as COVID-19, is a new strain of a virus that has been associated with the common cold, respiratory, and gastrointestinal illnesses. But how can you and your family stay safe during this global health emergency? Below are some key tips for preventing the spread of COVID-19:



- Social Distancing Limit participation in mass scale events and meetings.
- 2. **Self-Quarantine** Stay at home and away from others when sick.
- 3. *Hand Hygiene* Wash your hands vigorously for <u>20</u> <u>seconds</u> during the day, after bathroom visits, after coughing, sneezing, touching body surfaces, and touching others.
- 4. Clean & Disinfect Frequently Clean and disinfect high-touch surfaces (i.e. doorknobs, light switches, handles, desks, faucets, toilets, sinks) using household cleaners and disinfectants.
